

Gendered Intelligence Network for Therapists & Counsellors

Are you a therapist or counsellor who would like to improve your understanding of gender diversity or develop more trans-inclusive practice?

The Gendered Intelligence (GI) Network for Therapists and Counsellors aims to support professionals to enable a positive experience in a therapy setting for trans people and their families.

Joining the network entitles you to:

- Access group supervision/consultation (every 3 months, max. 12 people for 3 hours, £45/session)
- Be included in a directory aimed at trans people and their families (subject to criteria)
- Join the e-mail distribution list
- Receive a newsletter 4 times a year

Annual subscription: £80/year

To join the network, therapists and counsellors need to complete GI's two day course "Working Alongside Trans, Gender Diverse and Questioning People" (details overleaf). The first year's subscription can be included in the cost of the training.

We particularly welcome applications from therapists and counsellors who are themselves trans/gender diverse, particularly QTIPOC people.

Working Alongside Trans, Gender Diverse and Questioning People

This two-day course is for practising psychotherapists, counsellors, and therapists in the fields of talking therapies who are working with, or are interested in working with, trans and gender diverse people. It has been created in response to demand for more in-depth and specialist learning from therapists and counsellors themselves, and to the need of the trans community for a pool of trans-knowledgeable therapists and counsellors.

The training is a mix of formal presentations, interactive exercises and reflective discussions delivered in a small group learning environment by two professional trainers who combine extensive therapeutic and trans-specific knowledge and practice.

It covers topics including the broad picture of gender diversity; terminology and use of language; treatment pathways and medical contexts/WPATH standards of care; gender theory; psychotherapy practices that support work with trans and gender diverse people; and relevant law.
